## **DIOCESAN REGULATIONS – 2019**

#### Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

All Christ's faithful are obliged by divine law, each in his or her own way, to do penance. The Church, however, prescribes some days when all the faithful are in a special manner to devote themselves to prayer, to engage in works of piety and charity and to deny themselves, especially by observing the fast and abstinence (c.1249). Following Church Law and in accordance with the Apostolic Constitution "Penitemini" of Feb 27, 1966, some regulations and instructions for the year 2019 are given below. They are to be faithfully observed in our Diocese:

1. <u>DAYS OF FAST AND ABSTINENCE</u>: ASH WEDNESDAY (MARCH 06) and GOOD FRIDAY (APRIL 19). All Fridays of Lent are recommended as days of fast and abstinence in our Diocese.

Abstinence becomes mandatory from the age of 14, and fast from the age of 18 to 60.

- 2. <u>DAYS OF PENANCE</u>: ALL FRIDAYS OF THE YEAR, DAYS OF LENT AND ADVENT. Since on these days, one is no more bound by law to fast and abstain, a penitential work must substitute them. Substitution may be one of the following devotional practices and good works or similar ones:
- a). Assisting at Holy Mass with devotion
- c). Eucharistic Adoration
- e). Stations of the Cross
- g). Visiting the poor
- i). The Family Rosary

- b). Visit to the Church
- d). Reception of Communion
- f). Alms-giving
- h). Reading the Bible or Spiritual Books
- j). Bearing sickness or suffering patiently
- k). Visiting the sick either at home or in the hospital
- I). Engaging in other corporeal works of mercy
- m). Abstaining from watching movies or from smoking or from alcoholic drinks or such other means of recreation or luxury.
- 3. The <u>USUAL FACULTIES OF PARISH PRIESTS OR CONFESSORS</u> are still in force for dispensing substitutes, even in case of No. 1.
- 4. The <u>TIME FOR FULFILLING THE EASTER DUTY</u> begins on Ash Wednesday, i.e. March 06 and ends on The Solemnity of Most Holy Trinity i.e. JUNE 16.
- 5. <u>SUNDAYS AND HOLYDAYS OF OBLIGATION</u>: All Sundays of the year, Christmas (25th December) and Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (15th August).

The obligation of assisting at Mass is satisfied whenever Mass is celebrated in a Catholic Rite, either on a Sunday or Holyday itself or the previous evening (after 4.00 p.m.). One who has received Holy Communion may receive it once more on the same day only within a Eucharistic celebration in which he/she



participates (Can. 917). In other words, a person who assists at two or three Masses, say on All Souls' Day or Christmas Day, may receive Holy Communion at two Masses.

- 6. Days on which Parish Priests are obliged to offer MASSES (MISSA PRO POPULO) FOR THE FAITHFUL: (a) All the Sundays of the Year, (b) Christmas Day (Dec 25) & (c) The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (Aug 15).
- 7. The following COLLECTIONS FOR THE UNIVERSAL CHURCH must be made on the days mentioned in all the Churches and Institutions and sent to our Diocesan Curia:
  - A. For the Society of the Holy Childhood
  - B. For St. Peter's Pence
  - C. For Campaign against Hunger & Disease
  - D. For the maintenance of Holy Land
  - E. For the Society of St. Peter the Apostle
  - F. For the Society of the Propagation of Faith
- 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2019
- 18th August 2019 (Justice Sunday)
- During Lent (Maundy Thursday, 18<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2019)
- Good Friday, 19<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2019
- 29th June 2019
- Mission Sunday, 20<sup>TH</sup> October 2019
- N.B. On other Sundays of the year and Holydays of obligation, the collection should be taken for the maintenance of the church. Priests who take their monthly allowance from the Diocese must send the Sunday collection to the Curia. Other priests who do not take the monthly allowance from the Diocese may retain the Sunday collection for Church maintenance.
